All applications are subject to approval. Once an application has been received, a member of the Sparta Celtic Festival team will contact you to let you know if you have been accepted to the festival as a vendor. Once all vendor positions have been filled a waiting list will be created.

Merchant Vendors

Merchant vendors are business whose good are focused on Celtic merchandise. To be accepted by as a Merchant your items for sale must be 85% or more Celtic in nature.

Merchant vendors will be placed down in Rogers Park and will be able to set up Friday morning and be open for sales when the festival opens Friday at 4:00 pm. There will be security for overnight for vendors that sell Friday evening.

A single space is a 10 ft x 10 ft, a double space is a 10 ft x 20 ft area and all vendor spaces are outdoors. No table, tent, chairs, or electricity are provided. Vendor applications must be accepted by June 30, 2020. Any applications accepted after July 1, 2021 is subject to a late fee of \$25.00.

Cost of Booths:

10x10 Space: \$100 if application is received before June 30; \$125 if received after July 1

10x20 Space: \$150 if application is received before June 30; \$175 if received after July 1

Merchant Vendor Setup

Vendors can setup starting Friday at 2:00 pm. Saturday, setup is available beginning at 6:00 am. All vehicles must be removed from Rogers Park by 9:00 am. Setup must be completed by 10:00 am.

To guarantee your space at the standard fee, please apply no later than by June 30, 2021.
